

Suggestions approved:

- **Bufamo Village School, Uganda - £250 products**

A product donation was agreed for this remote school in Uganda. The school does not receive any state funding and is in desperate need of repairs.
- **Children of Honduras - £250 products**

The charity is based in Derby and is run by volunteers. They fundraise to send life saving supplies to poor children in Honduras. The charity has been running since 1974 after a Spondon lady sent a small aid parcel to a friend working in the slums of the country's capital.
- **Nicolle Herrington - £250 products**

The student teacher is travelling to Africa for three weeks in June to help underprivileged children. She plans to teach English, maths and sports. Nicolle is currently fundraising to pay for the trip.
- **Strawberry Hills Overseas and Community Concern - £1000 cash**

Kevin Cook is fundraising to build a girls school in Moshi, Tanzania. The fundraising started in 2007 and they raised £7000 which enabled them to build the foundations, walls and stairs. A further £10,000 is needed to complete the school and take their first children in September.
- **Street Child Work Cup Kick Off – FA Skills Footballs**

This project will bring teams of street children from around the world to play in a football tournament that will raise the profile of their human rights.
- **Jamie Parkinson - £250 products**

Jamie has a life-limiting muscle wasting disease, Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy, for which there is no cure. Jamie's family are fundraising with Action Duchenne to raise the profile of the disease and to fund research for a cure.
- **The Mamelodi Trust - £250 products**

The trust has been running for 12 years supporting teachers and children in Mamelodi, South Africa. There is a continuing growth of squatter camps and chronic under-funding and over-crowding of schools.
- **Vidyodaya School, India - £500 products**

The school was nominated by one of our fair-trade suppliers, Accord. Vidyodaya school is for children living in forest villages. Most of the kids are first generation literates and their families have taken the courageous step of seeking education. The school is in need of learning and craft materials.
- **Roorkee School, India - £500 products**

The school was nominated by one of our fair-trade suppliers, Sun Surveys. Employee's children attend this school and it is in desperate need of repairs and educational equipment. The school has no tables or chairs and the teaching suffers from the lack of equipment

3. **AOB**

- It was agreed to employ a part time term time administration assistant for the charity. Due to the growth of the charity the administration work involved is substantial. The administration person will also be tasked with building and maintaining links with local charities, CSR and fundraising. The role will be part funded by the charity and part by TTS.
- The charity foundation website now has its own blog for feedback and ideas.
- It was agreed to support 10 teachers with volunteering in developing countries. £250 of products per teacher to be donated. VSO to be contacted.
