

## Texture Bean Bags

### **Product Code: EY07515**

Let the children explore these beanbags. They can explore the textures and the patterns.

- Play finding the matching beanbag. Can you find the other metallic one or the spotty one?
- Talk about the textures. What do they remind you of? What does the stripey one look like? Is it like a rainbow? Is the black and white one like a cow?
- Look at the patterns. Can you find a red square with white spots? Is there one beanbag that is smooth, crinkly cotton, plastic, etc? Use this as an opportunity to talk about properties, whilst really enriching their vocabulary.
- The children may enjoy stacking the beanbags, using them like construction resources.
- They may balance them on their heads, backs and feet and try and walk around.
- Use them for throwing and catching games.
- Place them in a feely back and describe them without looking. You could try and find two of the same without looking, relying on feeling the textures.
- Play beanbag games, running to place them in a basket.
