

Sorting and Collecting Crate Top

This is a lovely addition to the crate collection as children are able to use little bowls to further their discovery and investigative skills. It is can make a great addition to all outdoor areas. The top is designed to fit into the TTS crate

- Use these crates alongside your mud kitchen for children to continue to create
 potions and concoctions. Ensure you have lots of materials and tools for children to
 explore with such as; pots, pans, Plastic Messy Play Potion Bottles (EY06701) etc.
 Allow children time to explore the materials. Let them mix, pour, mash, empty and
 fill and generally have fun experimenting.
- This can be used for maths outside. You can find different naturally found resources such as; acorns, conkers, pine cones etc. for children to sort into the bowls. They can sort them into categories such as; material, size, shape etc. You could even use the Rustic Numbers (EY10646) for children to use numbers to represent amounts.
- The top can be moved from crate to crate so children can have freedom in where they place this. They can carry this around your outdoor space. Children may create small spaces and dens outside, they may bring this top inside and collect items of interest to place inside the bowls.
- The crate top might be used as a dinner time scene.
- It could be used for sorting. Ensure you have spoons, tweezers etc. to assist fine motor skills.
- The crate could be used with buttons, beads, stones etc.
