- Each unit introduces new letters, sounds and high frequency words whilst also revising those previously taught.



### Dandelion Readers

- Parallel sets of books introduce the sounds of the alphabet, adjacent consonants, consonant digraphs, and vowel digraphs.
- Series 1-3 are parallel sets that follow the same phonic progression as the Launchers.
- The extended Levels 1-4 introduce vowel digraphs and common suffixes.

There are four books in each unit which provide practise whilst offering a range of stories. Each book introduces only a few sounds at a time allowing independent reading from the outset.


