Learning Intentions

Viking raids and invasions- To understand where the Vikings came from and how and why they invaded Britain.

Resistance by Alfred the Great & Athelstan- To understand how some kings in Britain dealt with the Viking invaders.

Viking Life- To understand how the Vikings lived and worked.

Suggestions for activities

Use Viking invasion map to identify the places Vikings came from and record facts known. Make a paper model of a Viking long ship to go on Bot and explore where they travelled to. Complete Viking timeline and order events.

As the Bot moves around the map, highlight and research facts about the British kings. Discuss similarities and differences.

Discover what their houses were like, what clothes they wore and what food they ate. Research aspects of Viking life.

Learning Intentions

Suggestions for activities

Further Viking invasions- To understand what happened during the Viking invasions and know what Viking warriors were like.

Direct the Bot to the Viking warriors and ask and find answers to questions about the warriors and the weapons they used.

Artefacts- Use artefacts to find out about the past. Piece together the story through close observation and questioning.

Identify and describe Viking artefacts. Research, record and feedback what you have learnt. Use the TTS artefact ideas sheets to explore artefacts further.

Beliefs- Know some Viking gods and what they represent.

Use the Bot to collect pictures of the Viking gods and match the pictures to the names.



Get pupils to design a quiz to test their friend's knowledge about what they have learnt. Groups could ask questions and the other group could programme the Bot to show their answers.
