How to guide...Hurricane Tube (SD10375)



The hurricane tube is a tube that lights up in 7 different colours and then, when turned on, tiny beads shoot up the tube creating a magical sensory experience for children to discover! Children can control and choose which light setting they would like and the intensity of the beads floating by pressing buttons on the front panel. It is similar to a bubble tube, but less hassle as the water doesn't need to be maintained and you can't accidentally spill anything out!





Why would it be used?

The hurricane tube would be used to provide visual stimulation, promote relaxation, and enhance focus. It can also be used as a stimulus to spark curiosity, wonder, and awe with the children. Imagine the first time they see it in a dark room – it can be a great opportunity to develop their communication and language skills too.



Who would use it?

A child with any of the following requirements may enjoy using the Hurricane Tube:

- A sensory diet
- Sensory processing disorders
- Sensory seeking input
- Support to regulate, or calming time

However, most children will enjoy watching and exploring the beads float up and down.

How is used?

Simply place the hurricane tube wherever you would like it and let your child explore. I would recommend putting it in a calming area of your classroom such as a book nook, sensory area, or a dark den. It would make a great addition to a sensory room. The hurricane is charged and then once charged, the wire is put away so it can be used and moved into position anywhere.

In summary...

The hurricane tube will mesmerise your child and help them to regulate through sensory stimulation, whilst stimulating the senses and providing an opportunity to develop communication and exploration skills.
