

Flower Garden

Here are some suggestions:

The garden has ten spaces so the children can post the flowers into position. They can count the flowers, adding and subtracting amounts. The flowers can also be used to make sequences and patterns.

- The children may choose to make their own vegetables and flowers. Make them from card and then laminate them for strength and durability.
- They could make their own Mr McGregor's garden (as in Peter Rabbit's story). Try making Mary Mary's garden with silver bells and cockle shells.
- The garden could also be used in a role play area, eg. outside the house, acting as a flower container.
- The holes also enable different cards to stand up. You could try placing number cards in the spaces. The children could then place the numbers in order. This could be done with numerals or amounts.
