Most **ADVERBS** tell us more about the **VERB**

Think - **'ADD** to the **VERB'**

Adverbs often (but not always) end in... **-ly**

ADVERBS ADD to the **VERB** by telling us

HOW it happens
e.g. quickly, slowly

WHERE it happens
e.g. here, there

WHEN it happens
e.g. today, early

and **BY HOW MUCH** it happens
e.g. very, much
