

Wooden 3D Threading and Lacing Trees 3pk

Product Code: EY05292

These delightful chunky trees can be used in small world play as well as being great for lacing and fine motor activities. (Assess for potential hazards eg. choking risks)

- Encourage the children to weave with different materials. We find that florist's ribbon works well as it can be shredded into various sized strips. You could also try wool, fabric, tinsel, string, etc. For older children you could incorporate beads, bells and buttons into the threading.
- Try using natural materials. You could place leaves in the branches of the trees. It could be a magical tree with feathers, sparkly paper, etc. Perhaps you could twist furry pipe cleaners into the branches.
- Create number trees. Position a numeral next to the tree and place corresponding amounts of something on it/in the tree. It could be five leaves, five birds, five squirrels etc. Encourage the children to count, match and recognise numerals and amounts.
